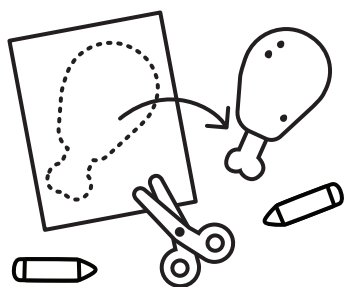

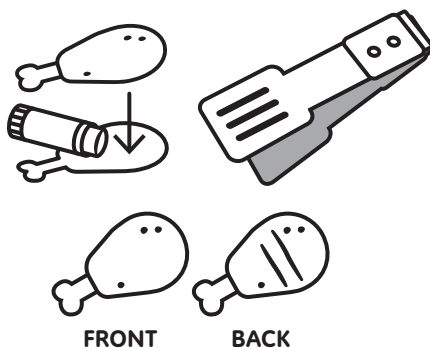


Instructions



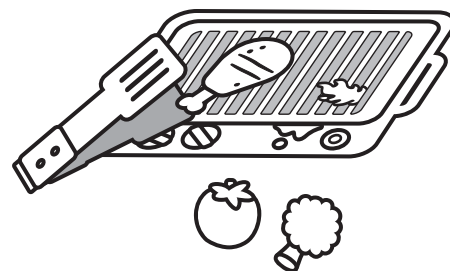
1. Color & cut

Color in the sheets. Cut out all the pieces along the dotted line. TIP: glue the tongs, sauce and brush pieces onto cardboard before cutting.



2. Food pieces and tongs

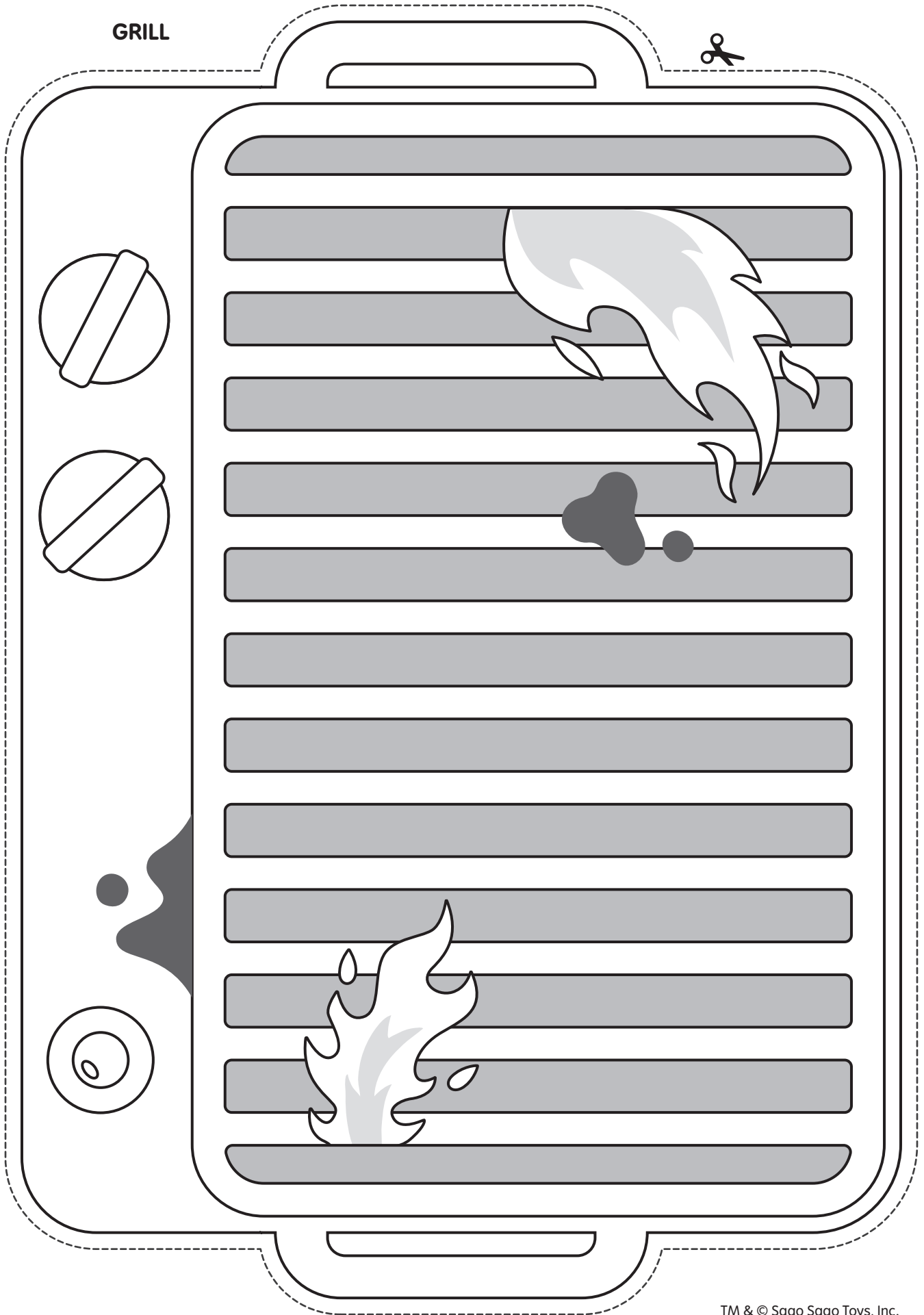
Glue the front and backs of all the food pieces together. Fold the tongs in half and use them to grab onto food pieces.



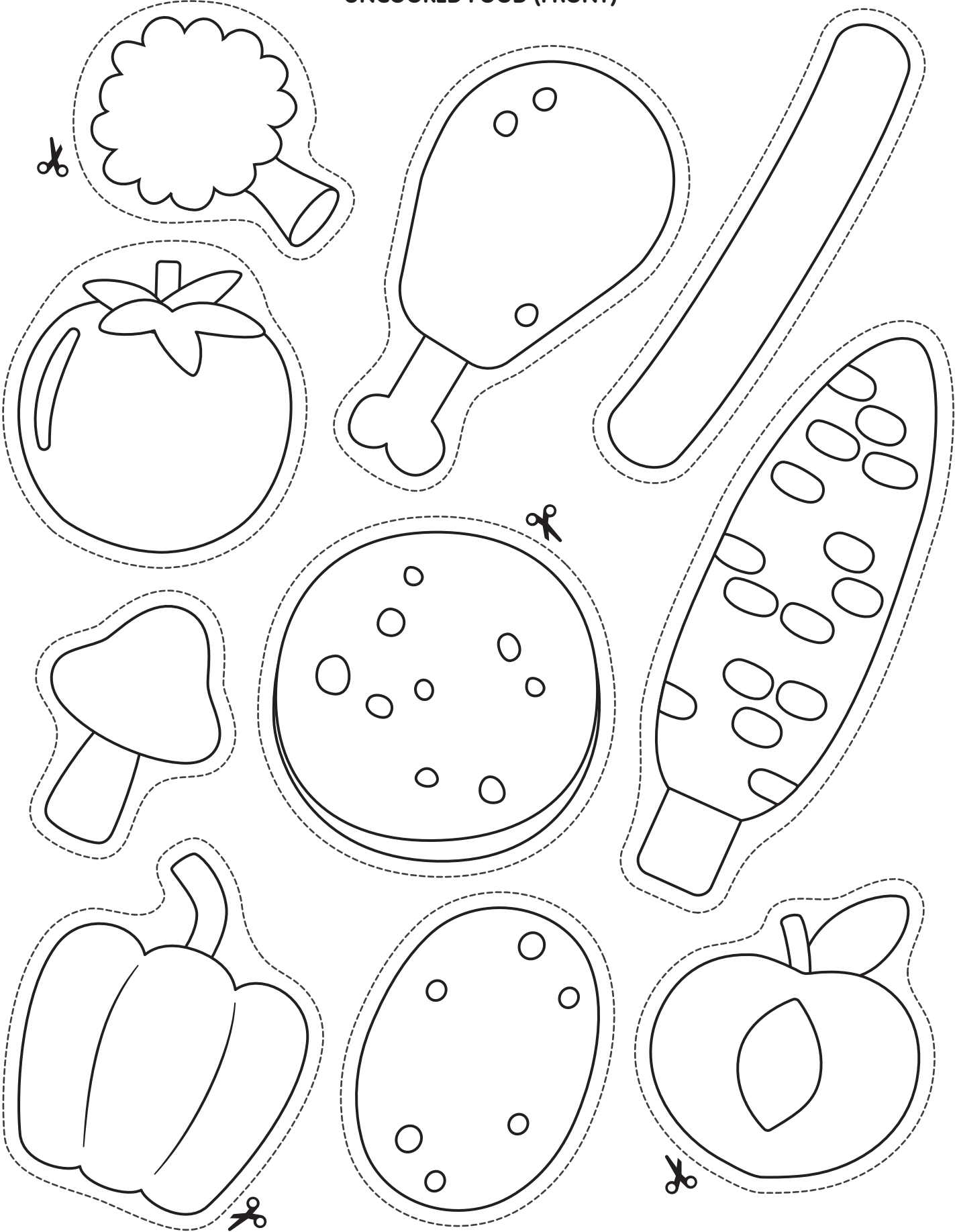
3. Get grillin'

Fire up the BBQ and lay the food pieces onto the grill. Use the tongs to flip food pieces over and see those grill marks!

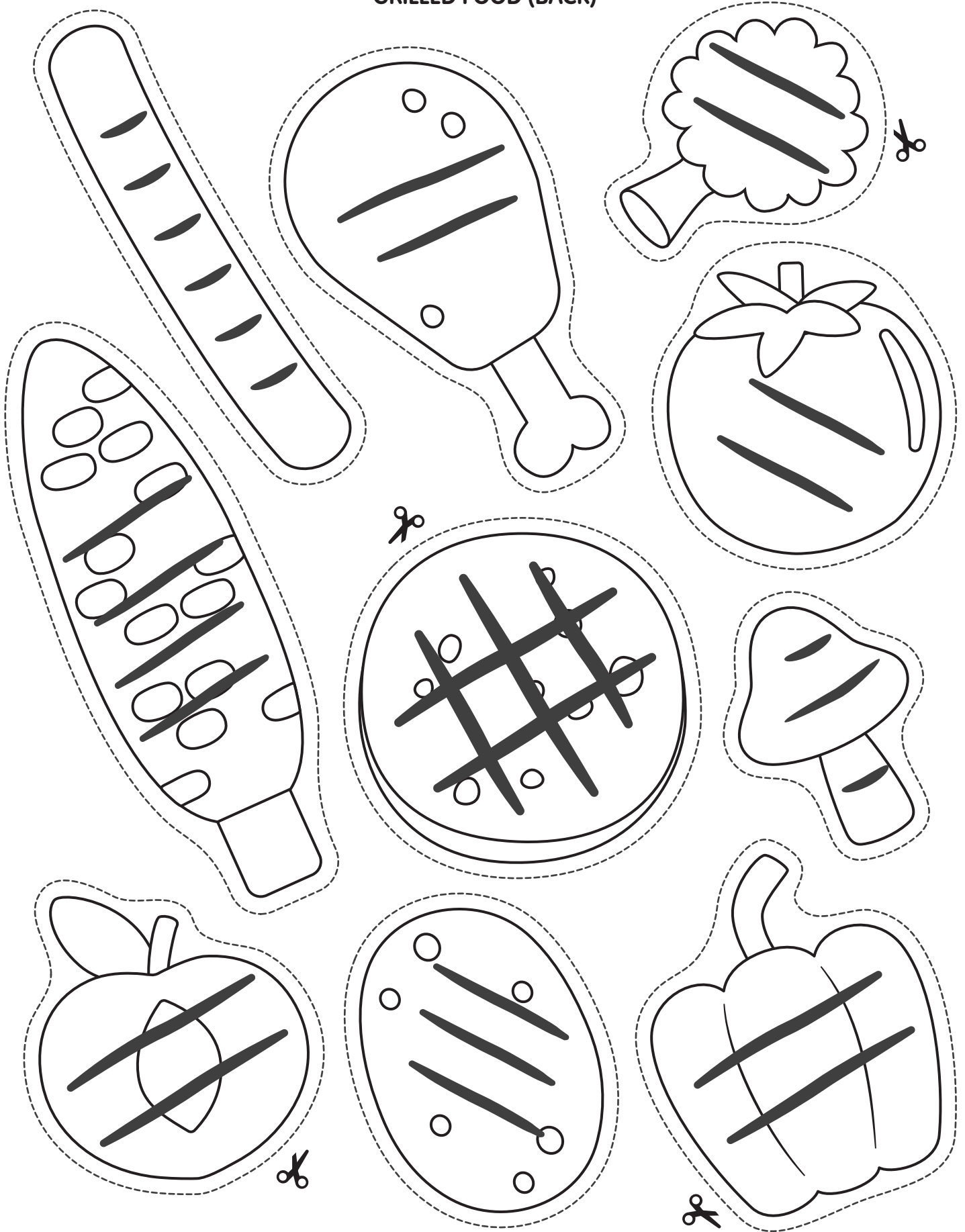

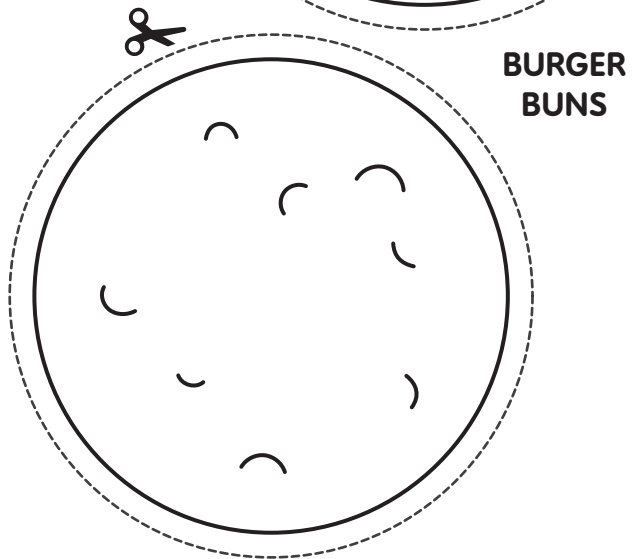
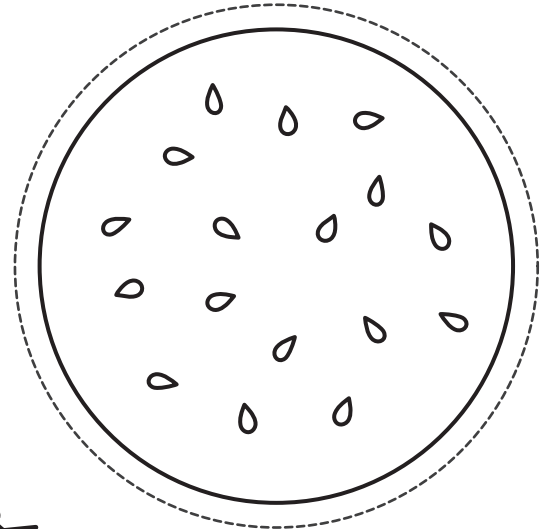
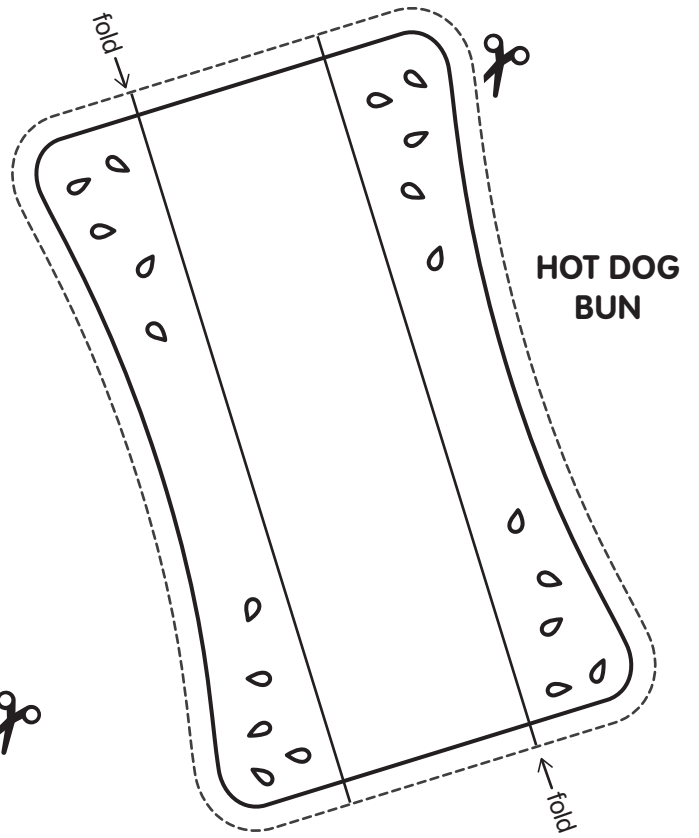
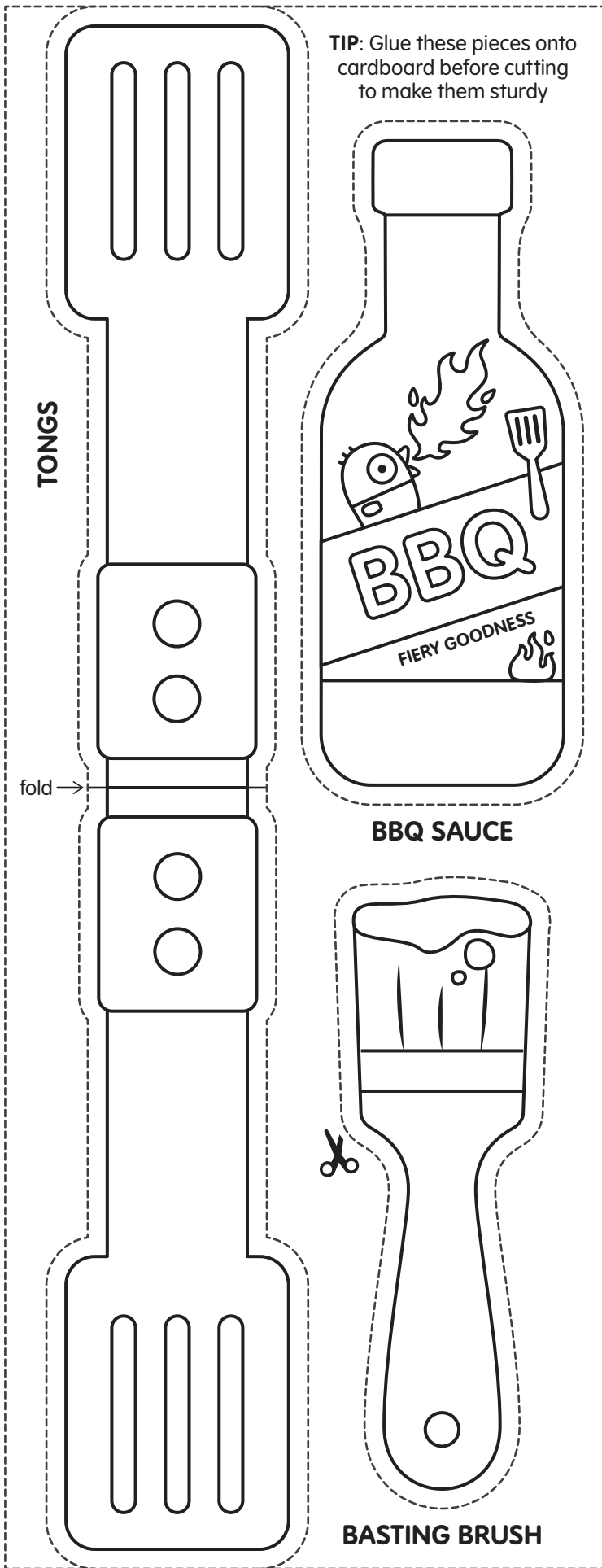


UNCOOKED FOOD (FRONT)

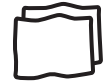

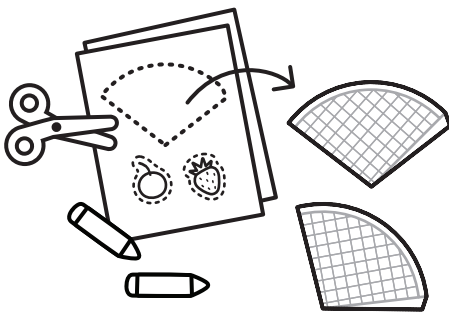

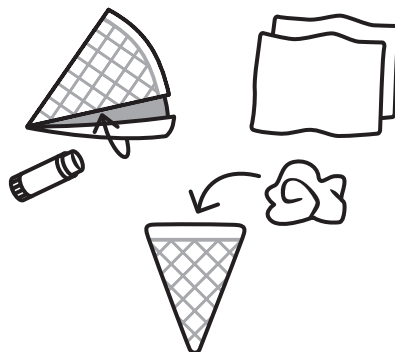


Instructions

2. Make cones and ice cream

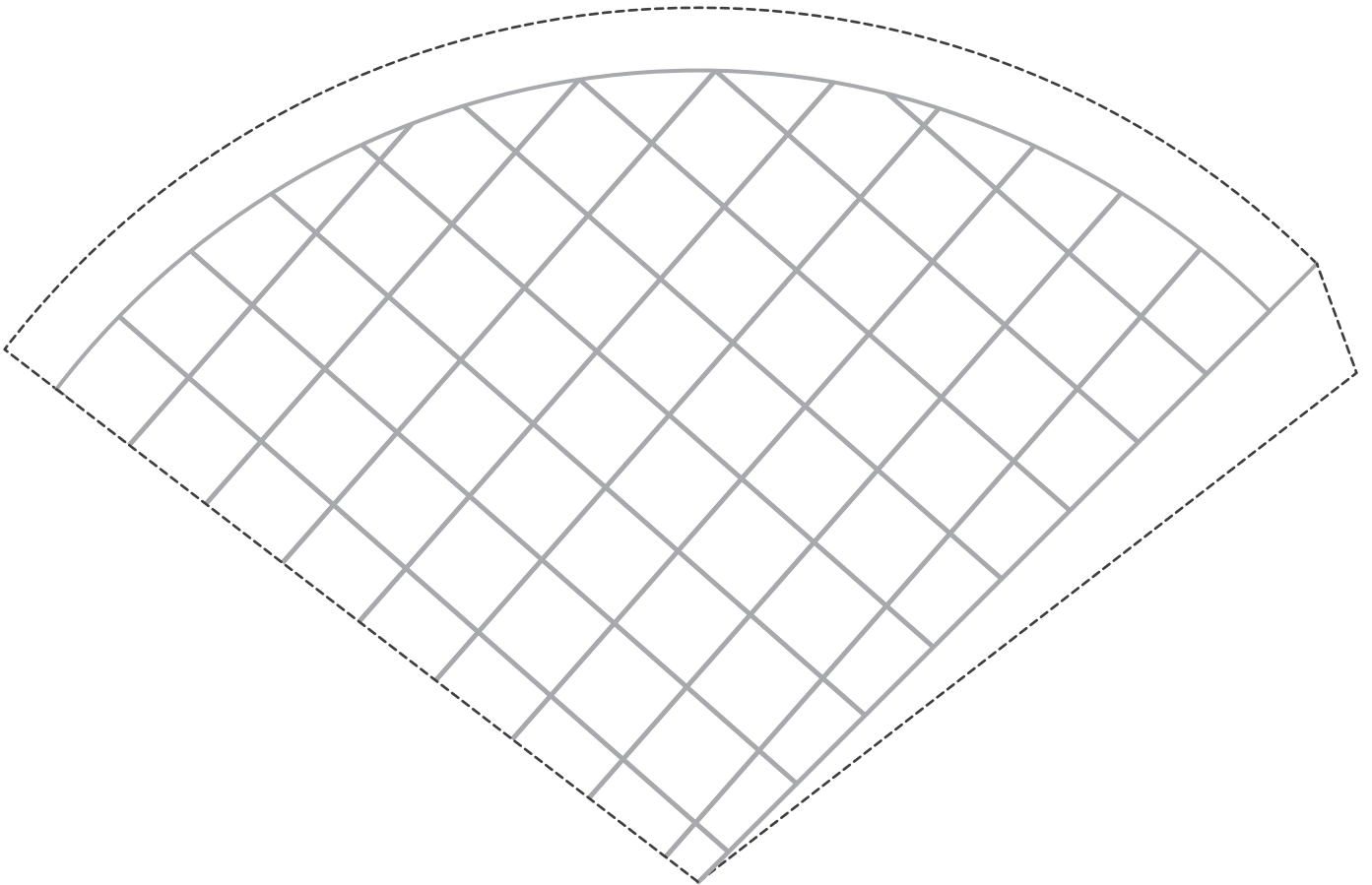
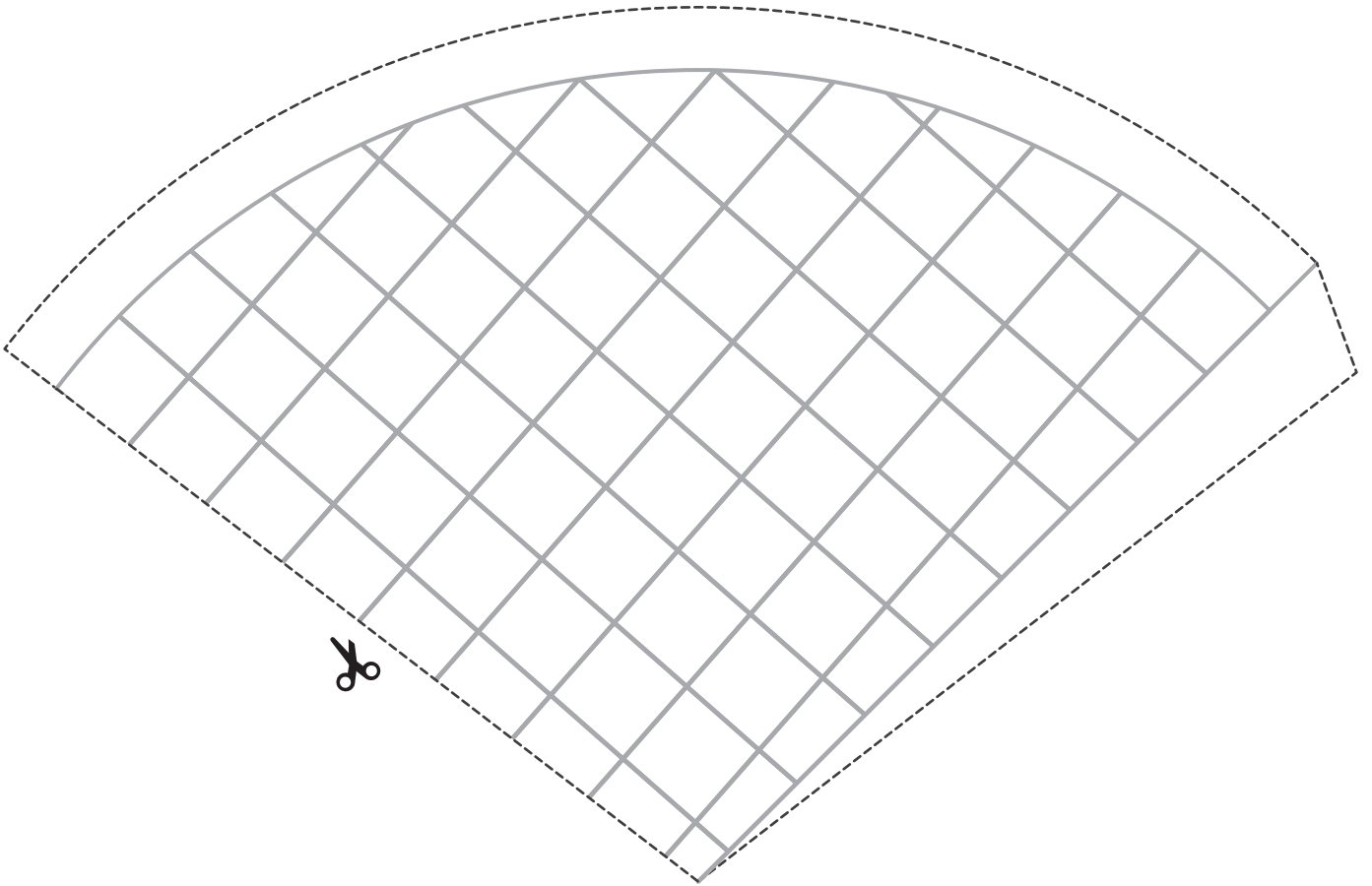
Assemble the cones and glue along the edge to secure. Scrunch up colored tissue paper into balls and place inside the cones.



3. Add toppings

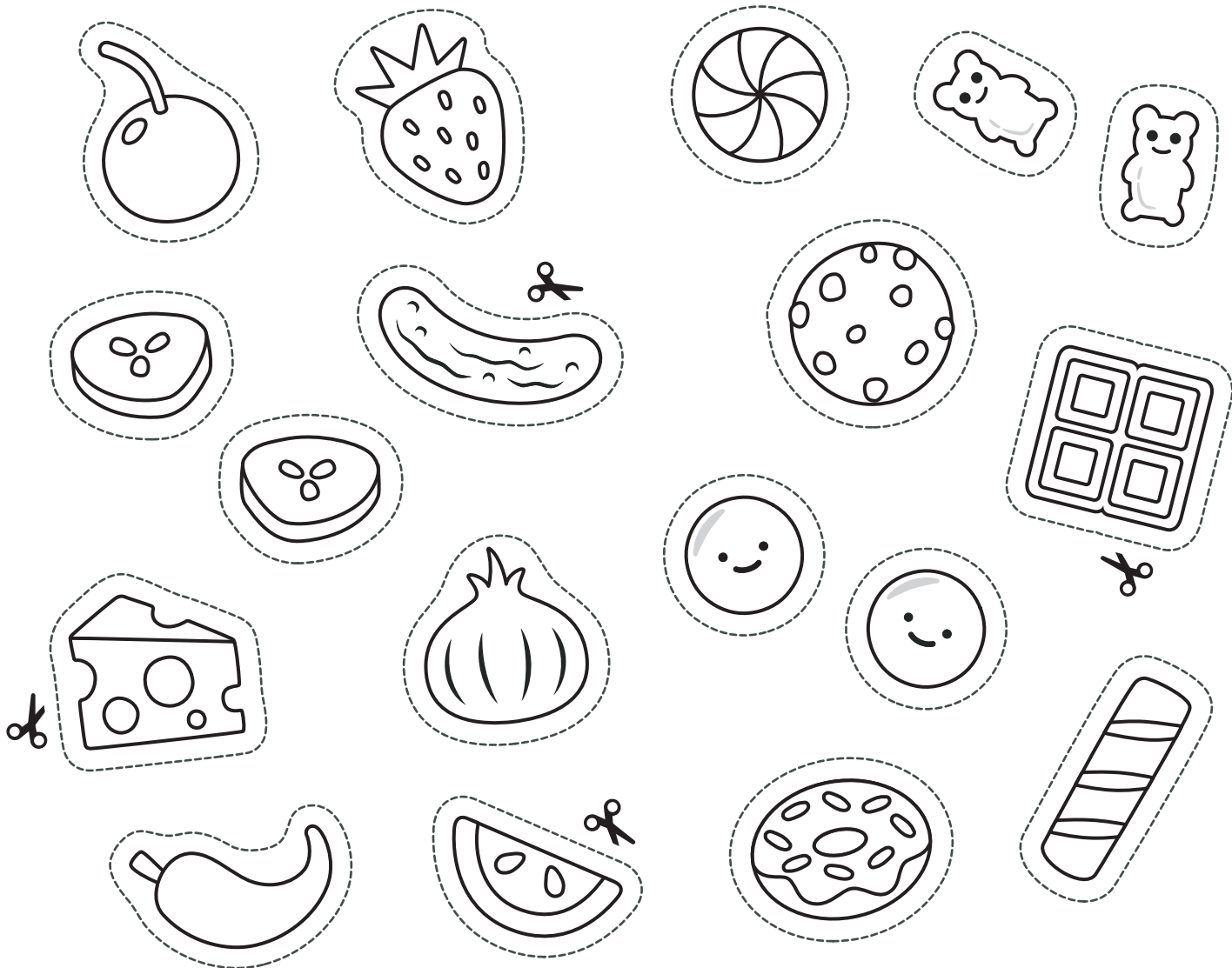
Choose your favorite toppings and glue them onto the tissue paper ice cream. Enjoy!
